Marking scheme for the selection of the guest faculty

The following breakup of marks/score will be adopted for selection of the guest faculty.

For Engineering Streams:

(A) Academic Record & Research Programme (Maximum Marks – 50)

to be awarded in following manner:

- (i) High School or Equivalent - **Maximum 5 Marks** to be distributed as per following manner-
 - (a) Below 60 % or **IInd Division** - 1 Mark
 - (b) Between 60 % but <75 % or **Ist Div** - 3 Mark
 - (c) 75% and above (**Honors**) - **5 Marks (Full Marks)**
- (ii) Intermediate or Equivalent – **Maximum 5 Marks** as per following
 - (a) Below 60 % or **IInd Division** - 1 Mark
 - (b) Between 60 % but < 75 % or **Ist Div** -3 Marks

- (c) 75% and above (**Honors**) -5 Marks (**Full Marks**)
- (iii) UG (B.E./ B.Tech. or Equivalent) - **Maximum 15 Marks** as per following
- (a) Below 60 % or **IInd Division** - 5 Mark
- (b) Between 60 % but < 75 % or **Ist Division** - 10 Marks
- (c) 75 % & above (**Honors**) - 15 Marks (**Full Marks**)
- (iv) P.G. (M.E./M.Tech.) – **Maximum 15 Marks** to be awarded as per following manner--
- (a) Below 60 % or **IInd Division** - 5 Marks
- (b) Between 60 % but < 75 % (**Ist Div**) - 10 Marks
- (c) 75% and Above (**Honors**) -15 Marks (**Full Marks**)
- (v) Ph.D. submitted/awarded -----**Maximum 5 Marks** to be awarded
- (a) Thesis Submitted-- 3 Marks
- (b) Thesis Awarded-- 5 Marks (**Full Marks**)

Teaching Experience –Maximum 2 Marks as per following to be awarded-

1 Marks per year of teaching Experience subject to **maximum 2 marks**.

Research Publications -Maximum 3 marks as per following to be awarded---

2 Marks for each paper published in a peer journal or **1 marks** per conference subject to maximum of **3 marks**.

(B) Assessment of Domain Knowledge & Teaching Skills (Maximum Marks – 30) ---

There shall be a Written Test for the **Domain Knowledge of Subject Area/ Specialization (20 marks) & Teaching Skills (10 marks)** respectively. The question paper will be of one hour duration and maximum marks will be 100. The question paper will be based on syllabus of GATE examination in Engineering & Technology Discipline. The question paper will be based on syllabus of CSIR-UGC, NET examination in Applied Sciences & Humanities Discipline.

The broad area of the **Domain Knowledge test (20 marks)** on the subject area/ specialization shall be as per syllabi of GATE Exam. **Teaching skills (10 Marks)** shall be, assessed based on the presentation.

(C) Interview Performance (20 Marks)—The candidates shall be interviewed by the Experts and the marks shall be awarded by the experts for a maximum 20 marks only.

The Final selection of the candidates, nevertheless, shall be based on their combined performance assessed on the basis of **section A (50 Marks), section B (30 Marks) & section C (20 Marks)** as described above.

For Applied Science & Humanities:

- (c) 75 % & above (**Honors**) - 15 Marks (**Full Marks**)

(iv) P.G. (M.A/M.Sc. or Equivalent) – **Maximum 15 Marks** to be awarded as per following manner--

- (a) Below 60 % or **IInd Division** - 5 Marks
(b) Between 60 % but < **75 % (Ist Div)** - 10 Marks
(c) 75% and Above (Honors) -15 Marks (**Full Marks**)

(v) Ph.D. submitted/awarded ----- **Maximum 5 Marks** to be awarded

- (a) Thesis Submitted-- 3 Marks
(b) Thesis Awarded-- 5 Marks (**Full Marks**)

(vi) Teaching Experience –**Maximum 2 Marks** as per following to be awarded-

1 Marks per year of teaching Experience subject to **maximum 2 marks.**

(vii) Research Publications -**Maximum 3 marks** as per following to be awarded---

3 Marks for each paper published in peer journals/**1 arks** per conference subject to maximum of **3 marks.**

(B) Assessment of Domain Knowledge & Teaching Skills (30 Marks) ---

There shall be a Written Test for the **Domain Knowledge of Subject Area/ Specialization (20 marks) & Teaching Skills (10 marks).**

The broad area of the **Domain Knowledge test (20 marks)** on the subject area/ specialization shall be as per syllabi of GATE Exam. **Teaching skills (10 Marks)** shall be, assessed based on the presentation.

(C) Interview Performance (20 Marks)—The candidates shall be interviewed by the Experts and the marks shall be awarded by the experts for a maximum 20 marks only.

The Final selection of the candidates, nevertheless, shall be based on their combined performance assessed on the basis of **section A (50 Marks), section B (30 Marks) & section C (20 Marks)** as described above.
