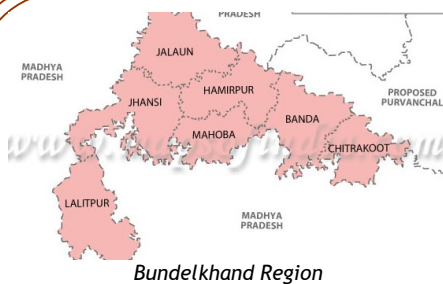


## Bundelkhand Region

Agriculture is the predominant occupation in Bundelkhand region. The share of farmers with marginal holdings i.e. less than one hectare is high (70.3 per cent) and productivity is low owing to the soil's poor water retention, weather fluctuations and large amounts of wasteland. The percentage of net irrigated area to net area sown is low in Bundelkhand region. There is acute shortage of water and women spend several hours daily to fetch potable water. Therefore, the state gross domestic product (State GDP) is very low i.e. Rs 280.00 (base year 2003-04) as compared to Uttar Pradesh which is Rs 690.00.

Presently to boost up the economy of the region, central government as well as, state government is trying to develop an industrial hub.

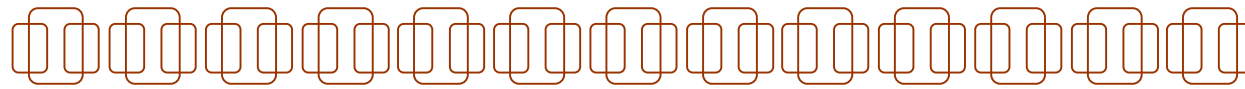
