(C) Interview Performance (20 Marks)—The candidates shall be interviewed by the Experts and the marks shall be awarded by the experts for a maximum 20 marks only.

The Final selection of the candidates, nevertheless, shall be based on their combined performance assessed on the basis of section A (50 Marks), section B (30 Marks) & section C (20 Marks) as described above.
