In the Interview process, all candidates have to appear in a written Test (1-Hour Duration) followed by the presentation (ppt) to demonstrate their domain knowledge and teaching skills, before the personal interview physically in front of the selection committee

(B) Management

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline and Master's Degree in Business Administration / PGDM / C. A. / ICWA/ M. Com. with First Class or equivalent and two years of professional experience after acquiring the degree of Master's degree.

(C) Qualifications for Faculties in Science and Humanities:

The qualifications for recruitment and promotions for faculty in the disciplines of Basic Sciences, Social Science and Humanities shall be as per the UGC Notification No. F.1-2/2017(EC/PS) Dated 18th July, 2018 and UGC guidelines issued from time to time.

(2) Assessment of Domain Knowledge and Teaching Skills (Maximum 30 Marks)

- (i) The MCQ based written Test (1-Hour)- 20 marks
 - (ii) The ppt presentation- 10 marks
- (3) Performance Assessment in Personal Interview (physically)-Maximum 20 Marks:** Average of the awarded marks by two subject experts out of 20 marks to the maximum of 20 marks only.

Based on the above 3-steps of assessment procedures the final selection of the candidates nevertheless shall be based on the cumulative performance assessed in the following:

- (1) Academic Assessment- 50 marks
 - (2) Domain Knowledge and Teaching Skills-30 marks
 - (3) Interview-20 marks
- Total-100 marks.
